



## TRAVELLING BACK IN TIME: From the Nineteenth Century to the Etruscan Age

4 Days / 3 Nights

The tour will bring you back in time, starting from the nineteenth-century historical district of the town of Follonica, passing through the medieval age in the area of Colline Metallifere, until reaching the age of our ancestors: The Etruscan.



### First Day

#### FOLLONICA “The Nineteenth-Century Industrial Area”

Arrival in Follonica. Welcome and check-in at the chosen accommodation facilities. Meeting with the guide and presentation of the tour program, beginning of the tour with the guided visit of Follonica. This charming town, overlooking the homonymous Gulf, became an important center during the Grand Duchy of Tuscany, when Leopold II transformed Follonica into an iron ore industrial center. The industrial facilities are still visible and some of them have been carefully restored to be used as Theatre and Museum. Dinner in a local typical restaurant to taste delicious seafood from our Gulf. Overnight stay.



### Second Day

#### MASSA MARITTIMA, GAVORRANO and SCARLINO

#### The MEDIEVAL Hamlets of Colline Metallifere

Breakfast, meeting with the guide, departure to Massa Marittima, the ancient chief town of Maremma, also said the “Gemstone of Medieval Age”. You will walk through the small streets of the old town and climb to the Candeliere Tower, to feel the mysterious and fascinating atmosphere of ancient times. Lunch with tasting of typical products. In the afternoon, the tour will bring you to the village of Gavorrano for a visit to its mine; and to the village of Scarlino to enjoy an amazing sunset on the Gulf of Follonica from the top of the Castle of Rocca. Back to the hotel, dinner in a local restaurant, overnight stay.



**Third Day**  
**VETULONIA and FOOD AND WINE EXPERIENCE “The Etruscan”**

Breakfast. Departure for an excursion in the area of Upper Maremma, cradle of the ancient culture of the Etruscan. You will pass through the village of Castiglione della Pescaia to reach Vetulonia to visit its Etruscan Museum and Necropolis. Lunch with tasting of local food in a winery owning a prestigious cellar. In the afternoon, visit to the Cellar and its small Etruscan museum, showing finds discovered in the ground of the vineyard. Return to Follonica, dinner in a local restaurant, overnight stay.



**Fourth day**  
**FOLLONICA and FAREWELL**

Breakfast, free time for a relaxing walk on the seaside and shopping, farewell and departure.
