Description

The National Archaeological Museum of Arezzo, named after Maecenas, preserves one of the most important archaeological collections in Tuscany and, together with the Roman Amphitheater, tells the ancient history of this city. The museum is located in the rooms of the former monastery of San Bernardo, a building with a singular curvilinear shape since it was built in the fourteenth century right on the remains of the amphitheater. The itinerary winds through 26 rooms arranged on two floors: on the ground floor we find finds that trace the history of Arezzo from Etruscan origins to late antiquity, while on the upper floor we find the prehistoric section, thematic rooms dedicated to ceramics, glass and precious metals, bronzes and numismatics.

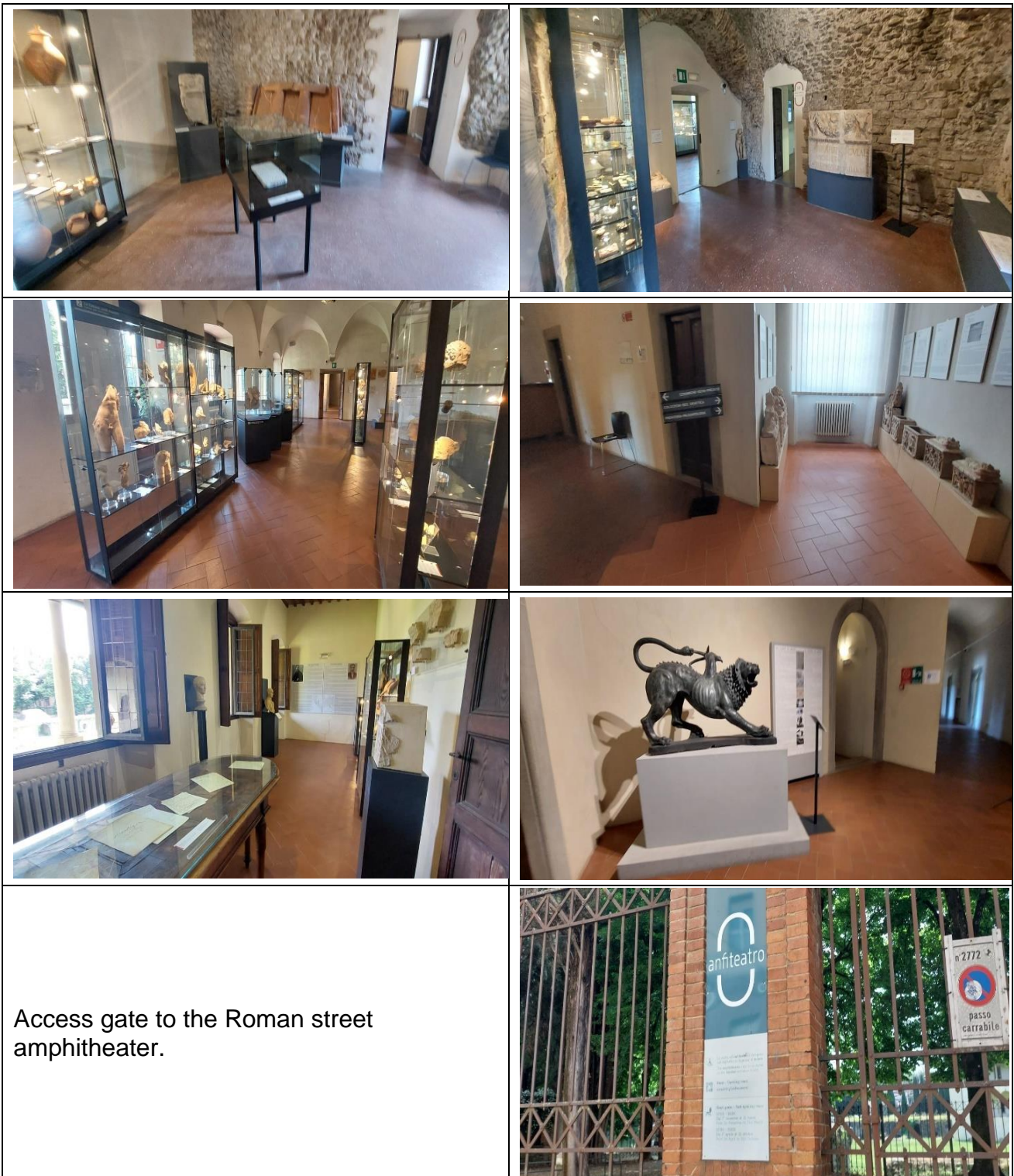
