Description

The Orecchiella Park is an area of 5218 hectares located in the upper Garfagnana, in the province of Lucca, on the north-western tip of Tuscany.

One of the paths in the Park, facilitated for people with disabilities, is **II Fontanone**, built years ago, but which has recently undergone renovation. The path is about 450 meters long with an average gradient of no more than 8% and develops in a coniferous forest; it is particularly recommended for the blind for the richness of sounds (birds, foliage, water) and scents. A wooden handrail makes the path on the valley side safe.

FONTANONE PATH 450 m
From the Casa dei Rapaci, to reach the Fontanone path, you have to overcome a path on a grassy ground, about 150 meters long, until you reach a gate, from which, during the opening period, you can access the Fontanone path by buzzing.
Alternatively, you can take the car again and reach the opposite side of the path, after about 600/700 m of paved road.tag.
Here begins a path, about 450 meters long, on a dirt road, with an average gradient of 6%, equipped with handrails on the sides and with a table inaccessible to the wheelchair. The path crosses a coniferous forest and is part of the major environmental recovery interventions that the State Forestry Corps has carried out in the Orecchiella area. In fact, in this part of the Monte Orecchiella Nature Reserve there is one of the oldest nuclei of these reforestations, dating back to the 30s.
