Description

The Puccini family, who had settled in Lucca in the first half of the eighteenth century, moved to Corte San Lorenzo in 1815. Giacomo Puccini was born here on December 22, 1858 and spent the happy years of his childhood, adolescence and early youth there. Although in the autumn of 1880 Giacomo moved to Milan to continue his studies at the Conservatory, this was still his home until 1884. In 1889 it was sold and bought back by Giacomo in 1894. On Puccini's death, the house passed to his son Antonio and on his death, in 1946, to his daughter-in-law, who, in 1974, donated Giacomo's birthplace to be transformed into a museum.



How to access the site	The Museum is located on the second floor of an architecturally bound historic residence, located beyond the statue dedicated to Puccini, which is located in front of the ticket office. From the ticket office you are accompanied by the staff in charge, in Corte San Lorenzo, to the building that houses the museum; The entrance can be reached via a sidewalk with a 12 cm high step and in succession a second 16 cm high step.
	The museum can be reached via a staircase with several steps, which could once be overcome by the "squirrel", a special aid on tracks that is no longer available and replaced, pending the installation of a stairlift, by the intervention of the assistance of mercy, to be requested a few days in advance and by reservation
Useful width of door/entrance gate	for the Puccini Museum door with 2 doors with opening of 67 and 110 cm opening the other door.

How to access



The **ticket office** is located 30 meters from the Puccini Museum in Piazza della Cittadella, 5, and can be reached by crossing the sidewalk, with a small step of 1.5 cm; the entrance is accessible on the flat with an internal glass door and a width of more than 90 cm

The internal flooring is in slightly irregular stone slabs.

Inside there is a bookshop and accessible toilets (see below)

The **reception** is located on the first floor of the Museum, which can currently be reached via a staircase with a desk height of 115 cm

How to access the rooms





☑ the museum can only be reached via a staircase; The first room is accessible via a short ramp (length 14 cm and width 85 cm with a slope of 18.5%) and precedes a room with the reception and an equipped bathroom.

The rooms are all accessible and can be visited, on the floor, except room 11, which can be reached from room 1 reception, via a ramp 195 cm long, > 90 cm wide and 8% slope, room 4 accessible via 3 steps and room 5 attic via staircase

The Museum is equipped with toilets equipped for the motor disabled, with a toilet equipped with a grab bar and enough space on the side for approaching with the wheelchair.
