Description

The San Rossore estate represents an extraordinary heritage for the **Tuscany region**. It is part of the **Migliarino San Rossore Massaciuccoli Regional Park**.

In **1862**, the **Savoy family** took possession of the estate and renovated many of the buildings that existed at the time and made it their exclusive summer and hunting residence. With the fall of the monarchy in Italy, the Estate became part of the state property and in **1957** it was assigned to the **Presidency of the Republic**.

In **1999** the management of the Estate passed definitively to the **Tuscany Region** and then to the **Park Authority**

Description of the Visitor Center



The **Visitor Centre**, accessible via a short connecting ramp, is an information office where illustrative material is available and it is possible to buy publications on the Park territory and gadgets.

Meeting point for guided and educational tours on foot, by bicycle, by bus

Environmental education activities are carried out by environmental hiking guides.







It has an ecological train equipped with a platform to accommodate a person in a wheelchair. 2 handbikes, special three-wheeled bikes for people with motor disabilities in the lower limbs are available for free rental. It is also possible to rent bicycles equipped with child seats to carry small children, cycle carriages and tandems, also ideal for the blind and travel long stretches of paved road or dirt roads, inside the woods.

In the immediate vicinity there is an outdoor area for packed lunches and picnics and accessible toilets







Mini-cruise of the Pisan Lungarno

Discovering the history of Pisa, which can be booked at the Visitor Center, departing from Cascine Nuove accessible via a path of about 100 meters on a dirt road and compact gravel, partly equipped with wooden handrails, with large spaces inside the boat.

In the internal paths and paths there are maps and tactile signs for the blind	YES along the path handrails and wooden curbs on the sides
Route description	The path is located along the Via del Gombo, about 400 meters from the prohibition of car circulation with a barrier; For those with reduced mobility, it is possible to request a permit from the Park office.
	Before reaching the beginning of the path you can meet fallow deer and, just before the barrier, along a large parking lot there is an area set up as a barbecue with tables and benches.
	Along the path it is possible to meet fallow deer and foxes and observe the many birds that live and pass through these places at different times of the year















The path is one kilometer long and 1 meter and a half wide and can be traveled by people with different abilities thanks to the bottom compacted with natural resins and with the blocking power of the earth-colored stabilized.

The path is equipped with wooden handrails and / or curbs and information signs that are easily readable even by those sitting in wheelchairs.



At the end of the path there is a bird observatory that can be reached via a short path of about 20 meters on a compact dirt road and a ramp equipped with a handrail with a slope of less than 8% Here there are several slits at a height that is also suitable for those sitting in wheelchairs.

Walking along the road of the hippodrome, we arrive at the restaurant and hotel La Sterpaia
