

Viaggi organizzati per gruppi di adulti, studenti e pellegrinaggi

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TREKKING IN MAREMMA 7 days / 6 nights

First day: we will meet our customers at Grosseto train station. After that, we will begin to visit the city, which is entirely preserving the old defensive walls. Today we will visit the cathedral, which is dedicated to Saint Lawrence, and also the archaeological Museum, where it is possible to admire ancient finds, since the Etruscan age. In the afternoon, it will be possible to visit the Cassero Senese, a Medieval build, which is representing the first defensive structure. After that, we will arrive at our holiday farm to spend the night.

Second day: breakfast at the hotel. By minivan, we will arrive at the Maremma Regional Park in order to spend a wonderful day in its savage nature. The path goes through the Park and it is possible to admire the ruins of St. Rabano's Abbey in a large clearing surrounded by holm oaks. In the nearby we can find the church dedicated to S. Maria Alborense (XI century). Now, there are just ruins, after that Siena destroyed most of the structures in 1438. In the afternoon, we will go back to our holiday farm to spend the night.

<u>Third day</u>: breakfast at the hotel. After we checked-out, we will reach, by minivan, the Lago di Burano WWF Oasis, near the town of Ansedonia. Actually, the lake is a salty pond, which is connected to the sea by an artificial channel. The lake is 350 acres wide and it is 1 yard deep. From the beach, which is 7.5 miles long, it is possible to find the coastal typical flora, while, in the nearby there is a sand dune covered by the Mediterranean scrub. In the early afternoon, we will go to Feniglia, a long beach, that is connecting Monte Argentario to the mainland. Here, in 1610, the painter Michelangelo Merisi (also known as Caravaggio) arrived, fleeing from Naples. After the visit, we will reach Porto Ercole to on-board to our boat, a 100 years old schooner. It will be a magnificent sailing experience. We will have dinner on the boat and we will spend the night there.

Fourth day: the boat will leave from Porto Ercole in the morning, heading to Giannutri Island. We will have breakfast on board. This island represents a protected area characterized by a savage flora. Here it is possible to admire an ancient Roman villa, right near the point of arrival. In the afternoon, we will go to Giglio Island. Today we will be able to visit this island, which is the second biggest one in the Tuscan Archipelago. We will have the opportunity to visit, on the top of it, the old town, which was funded in Medieval age and where it is possible to see Spanish elements, due to its dominion during the XVI and XVII centuries. We will spend the night on board.

<u>Fifth day</u>: breakfast on board. In the morning we will go back to Porto Ercole, to leave the boat. By minivan, we will reach the tuff's area, where we will have the opportunity to follow the path from San Quirico to the rocky village of Vitozza, characterized by caves, Etruscan structures and ruins of a Medieval town. From here, we will reach the near town of Sovana. In the afternoon, we will visit the famous necropolis, named Ildebranda after the Pope Gregory VII, who was born in Sovana. After the visit we will go back to our holiday farm, near Grosseto, where we will spend the night.

<u>Sixth day</u>: breackfast at the hotel. By minivan, we will reach the Maremma Regional Park, again. During this last visit we will arrive to Cala di Forno beach. Once, this location was representing the border between the Grand Duchy of Tuscany and the Spanish Presidios. In fact, the area which goes from Cala di Forno to the current border between Tuscany and Lazio, during the XVI and XVII centuries was actually Spain. In the late afternoon, we will go back to our holiday farm, where we will spend the night.

<u>Seventh day</u>: breakfast at the hotel. After we have checked-out, we will have some time a tour disposal to be spent for a further walk in Grosseto. After that, our customers will go back to their departure locations.
